New Show Protocols

In light of the situation surrounding Covid-19, we have instituted the following protocols to ensure that our shows operate in the safest manner possible. We ask that all competitors, spectators and trainers comply with these protocols.

Pre-Show:

- We will be scheduling ride times by trainer to allow larger groups to get in and out and not be hanging around all day. Please list your trainer's name on the bottom of your entry form and let us know whether or not your trainer will be accompanying you to the show.
- Please let us know at the time of entry if you will be trailering with another rider to the show so that we can schedule your times close together.
- ALL Entries, Coggins (Within one year of date of show), Proof of Flu/Rhino (Within 6 months of date of show) and Payments **MUST** be **Received** by the closing date of the show. No late entries will be accepted and no paperwork will be accepted on the day of the show. Only our new entry form, which can be found on our website, will be accepted. Please do not postdate your checks any later than the closing date of the show.
- Competitors, Trainers, Support Persons, Volunteers, Show Management and Officials are responsible for self-monitoring their health for 14 days leading up to the show date. If they come into contact with any Covid+ persons or suspected Covid+ persons or if they exhibit any symptoms, they may not appear at the showgrounds. Competitors **MUST** provide, with their entry, the names of any Support Persons who will be accompanying them to the show (limit 2).

Show Day:

- All competitors, volunteers, officials, support persons, etc. must take their temperature on the day of the show and only report to the show if it is below 99.5°F.
- We will require every person entering the showgrounds (not just competitors) to sign the USEF and HCEC Liability Waivers which are also found on our website. Those forms must be completed and signed in advance and brought to the show on the day of the competition and must be handed to the volunteer at the entrance to the trailer parking.
- Trailers must be parked at least 20 feet away from other trailers. If you have come as a group, you may move between trailers. If you have not come as a group, do not approach other trailers or cars.

- Each competitor may be accompanied by their trainer and no more than two support persons. Upon leaving your trailer/car, unless mounted, all parties must be in possession of a face-covering that they can use when there is a possibility of being within six feet of any other individual, not from their same household, until returning to their trailer/car. There will be no penalty for any competitor who chooses to wear their mask in the ring, but it is not required.
- Competitor's packets can be picked up at the table just inside the front doors of the barn. If this is your first show of the year at Hidden Creek, your number will be inside your packet. This will be your number for **all** shows at Hidden Creek in 2020 including the NPASS Championships, so please don't lose it!
- Spectators will be limited to trainers and the rider's own 1-2 support persons and they must remain in the designated seating area. If you are riding in the indoor ring, only your support persons and trainer will be permitted to watch from a window outside the ring. Trainers and support persons must remain spaced out at least 10 feet from other trainers and groups at the warm-up ring. To the greatest extent possible, trainers should coach from outside the warm-up ring. Please encourage your riders to utilize the entire warm-up ring and not congregate by the gate.
- Upon completion of your tests, please load your horse and leave as quickly as possible to limit the number of people on the show grounds. Unless you have trailered with someone, you should not be waiting for others to ride or being a spectator.
- The Show Secretary will email or text you a photo of the front and back of your test once it has been scored. Please check it over carefully and contact the Show Secretary immediately should you discover an error. Final Class Results will be posted on the Hidden Creek Website as soon as possible following the completion of the show. Tests and Ribbons will be mailed or delivered to the Trainers or Competitors within a week of the show.
- Concessions will not be offered at our shows this year; however, bottled water will be available for all competitors at the warm-up ring.
